CATTLE ENTRIES

Stall bookings (BEEF & DAIRY) together with full remittance must be received by the Secretary not later than Friday 17th July 2015. Full details of individual dairy animals entered must be submitted to the Secretary by Friday 31st July 2015. These dates will be strictly adhered to as a catalogue of entries has to be produced by the Show day. Failure to meet these deadlines will entail disqualification and forfeit of all fees paid.
